St. Luke's McCall Fiscal Year 2023 Funding Request

To: McCall Memorial Hospital District Board of Trustees

Pursuant to the Healthcare Services Agreement entered into on February 5, 2016, between St. Luke's McCall (SLM) and the McCall Memorial Hospital District (District), SLM hereby requests funding of \$1,355,559.00 from the District for St. Luke's fiscal year 2023 (10/1/2022 through 9/30/2023) to support and sustain critical healthcare programs and services.

The funding will be specifically used for costs to renovate the Allen Nokes building and the associated parking lot for the purpose of implementing an Urgent Care for the McCall Community. Funding allocation amounts are as follows:

Renovation/Construction costs for Urgent Care and associated patient and staff parking	(\$1,355,559)

### **St Luke's McCall Urgent Care**

Improving Access to Care- funding for the Urgent Care in McCall would increase access to clinic appointments by extending hours of service as well as additional coverage on the weekends. An estimated 2,098 additional visits per year or 6 visits per day are anticipated.

Affordable Care- access to an urgent care would allow an outlet for community members and tourist to access a more affordable care delivery model.

Improving Access to Care- Patients and employees need additional parking at Allen Nokes building to access and provide services for Urgent Care and Surgical Services which are both located in Allen Nokes building.

### **What does it mean for the District to fund these services?**

Funding this projects allows for better access and an avenue for more affordable care of the community of McCall and the people we serve.

### **Next steps**

SLM respectfully requests \$1,355,559 in funding in FY23 for Urgent Care and Parking upgrades.
